



Info for your stay

• Opening hours:

Reception, shop, clubhouse and restaurant
Daily from 8:30 am. to 9:00 pm.
Hot meals served from 11:30 am. to 8:00 pm.
Mon. and Tue. meals from 5:00 pm. to 8:00 pm.
(April and October
until 8:00 pm., kitchen until 7:00 pm.)

• Check-out

On the day of departure, we ask that you vacate your pitch by 11:30 am. Late departures is possible for an additional charge, depending on space availability. Please ask at reception.

• Quiet times:

Quiet hours are in effect throughout the campsite between 10:00 pm. and 7:00 am. The entrance to the campsite is closed during this time.

• Day visitors

Our parking spaces near the sanitary building are available for your visit.
Please register and pay at reception.
Day visitors CHF 3.-- per person, car CHF 4.--, overnight guests CHF 10.--

• Departure in heavy rain

In heavy rain, our meadow becomes very soft and muddy, making it difficult to drive away. Do not try to drive out with full force. Come to reception and we will help you leave the site.

• Electric cars

It is prohibited to charge electric cars at the power column on the pitch.
Ask at reception for alternatives.

• Awning carpets:

We are a natural campsite and do not want carpets, plastic tarpaulins or bus awnings with solid floors in front of the camper to keep our meadow green.

A small doormat (max. 1x1m) is allowed.

• Barbecues and fire pits

Open fires and fire bowls are not permitted. Barbecuing with gas or charcoal is permitted, but please do so in a way that does not disturb your neighbours (smoke, etc.). The barbecue must not scorch or burn the lawn; short-legged barbecues and disposable barbecues are not permitted on the lawn (minimum distance of 40 cm). Wood fires are only permitted on the communal fire pit.

• Recycling, camper service, clothes lines

Recycling and waste must be disposed of in sealed bin bags in the designated containers. Electrical appliances, bulky waste and tents of any kind must be disposed of by the owner. **Waste water** must not be poured outside from caravans or discharged into the ground. Waste water and toilet buckets may only be emptied in the special disposal area at the sanitary building.

It is prohibited to pour waste water into the drains of the water taps or to wash dishes there.

It is not permitted to put up **clothes lines** (risk of injury).

• Playing

A children's playground is available for children. Parents are obliged to supervise their children. The Camping Sihlwald association accepts no liability for personal injury or property damage of any kind, including accidents. Please keep the playground and surrounding area tidy. Return and tidy away any toys you have used.

• Billiards / table tennis / table football:

Equipment can be obtained from reception. A deposit of CHF 10 is required. Minimum age for billiards is 14.

• Dogs:

Dogs are not allowed in the sanitary facilities or in the clubhouse. Dogs must be kept on a leash throughout the entire site. Cats are not allowed.
